General Policies:

- Class times - Parents need to be responsible in knowing the dates of their child's class. Children must be picked up promptly at end of class. Two (2) late pick-ups and child may be dismissed from class without a refund.
- Transportation - Parents are responsible for each child's transport.
- Behavior - All students are expected to participate in class, stay in his/her class, respect school property and that of others, and be courteous to the instructor and other students.
- Discipline - All school rules apply and respectful behavior is expected. The teachers are there to teach your children, not babysit. The Instructor has the option to permanently dismiss any student who misbehaves. No refund of tuition will be given.
- PEAKS classes observe all Jefferson County holidays and scheduled closures. Weather closures ordered by the school or district will be refunded or rescheduled.
